Dipthongs When two vowels combine to make one sound, it is called a dipthong. There are seven dipthongs in Greek:

| $\alpha t$ | Like "ai" in "aisle" |

| $\varepsilon t$ | Like "ei" in "freight" |
| ot | Like "oi" in "oil" |
| $\alpha v$ | Like "ow" in "cow" |
| $\varepsilon v$ | Like "e-w" in "Edward" |
| $o v$ | Like "oo" in "food" |
| $v i$ | Like "uee" in "queen" |
