

Diphthongs When two vowels combine to make one sound, it is called a diphthong. There are seven diphthongs in Greek:

αι	Like “ai” in “aisle”
ει	Like “ei” in “freight”
οι	Like “oi” in “oil”
ου	Like “ow” in “cow”
ευ	Like “e-w” in “Edward”
ου	Like “oo” in “food”
υι	Like “uee” in “queen”
