The forms of the imperfect active indicative are the following:

### Singular

- 1. ἔλυον, I was loosening
- ἔλυες, you (sing.) were loosening
- 3. ἔλυε(ν), he, she, it was loosening

#### Plural

- 1. ἐλύομεν, we were loosening
- 2. ἐλύετε, you (pl.) were loosening
- 3. ἔλυον, they were loosening

## 66. Forms of the Augment

Present ἄγω, I lead ἀκούω, I hear ἐγείρω, I raise up ἔχω, I have

όφείλω, I am obligated αἴρω, I take up εὑρίσκω, I find Imperfect ἦγον, I was leading ἤκουον, I was hearing ἤγειρον, I was raising up εἶχον, I was having, I had (irregular augment) ὤφειλον, I was obligated ἦρον, I was taking up ηὕρισκον, I was finding (but also εὕρισκον

# Compound verbs

ἀποθνήσκω, I die ἀποκτείνω, I kill καταβαίνω, I go down

ἀπέθνησκον, I was dying ἀπέκτεινον, I was killing κατέβαινον, I was going down
