

65. The Imperfect Active Indicative

The forms of the imperfect active indicative are the following:

Singular

1. ἔλυον, I was loosening
2. ἔλυες, you (sing.) were loosening
3. ἔλυε(ν), he, she, it was loosening

Plural

1. ἐλύομεν, we were loosening
2. ἐλύετε, you (pl.) were loosening
3. ἔλυον, they were loosening

66. Forms of the Augment

Present

- ἄγω, I lead
- ἀκούω, I hear
- ἐγείρω, I raise up
- ἔχω, I have

- ὀφείλω, I am obligated
- αἶρω, I take up
- εὕρισκω, I find

Imperfect

- ἤγον, I was leading
- ἤκουον, I was hearing
- ἤγειρον, I was raising up
- εἶχον, I was having, I had (irregular augment)
- ᾠφειλον, I was obligated
- ἤρον, I was taking up
- ἠύρισκον, I was finding (but also εὔρισκον)

Compound verbs

- ἀποθνήσκω, I die
- ἀποκτείνω, I kill
- καταβαίνω, I go down

- ἀπέθνησκον, I was dying
- ἀπέκτεινον, I was killing
- κατέβαινον, I was going down
