90. Vocabulary

εἶδον, I saw (serves as the 2nd aorist of ὄραω) (idea)

εἶπον, I said (serves as the 2nd aorist of λέγω, a verb to be learned later) (epic)

ἦλθον, I came, went (serves as the 2nd aorist of ἔρχομαι)

ἤνεγκα, I brought, bore, carried (irregular 1st aorist of φέρω, conjugated with -κα, not -σα)

οἶνος, ó, wine (oenophile)

ὄψομαι, I will see (serves as the deponent future of ὄραω)

πίνω, πίομαι, ἔπιον, I drink, I will drink, I drank (pinocytosis)

πίπτω, ἔπεσον, I fall, I fell

προσέρχομαι, I come to, approach (usually + dative)

προσφέρω, I offer, present

σημεῖον, τό, sign, miracle, portent (semaphore)

φάγομαι, ἔφαγον, I will eat, I ate (deponent future, 2nd aor. of ἐσθίω)

φεύγω, φεύξομαι, ἔφυγον, I flee, I will flee, I fled (fugitive)
