βάλλω, I throw	βέβληκα, I have thrown
ὁράω, I see	έώρακα, I have seen
γίνομαι, I become	γέγονα, I have become
γινώσκω, I know	ἔγνωκα, I have come to know
γράφω, I write	γέγραπται, It is written
ἐγείρω, I raise up	ἐγήγερται, He, she has been raised
ἔρχομαι, I go	ἐλήλυθα, I have gone
ἐτοιμάζω, I prepare	ἠτοίμακα, I have prepared
εὕρισκω, I find	εὔρηκα, I have found
ἔχω, I have	ἔσχηκα, I have had
θνήσκω, I die*	τέθνηκα, I have died, I am dead
λαμβάνω, I take	εἴληφα, I have taken
λέγω, I say	εἶρηκα, I have said
πείθω, I persuade	πέποιθα, (act.) I depend on, trust
