αἷμα, -ατος, τό, blood (hemo-)
αἰών, αἰῶνος, ὁ, age, world (eon)
ἀνήρ, ἀνδρός, ὁ, man, husband
(android, androgynous)
ἄρχων, ἄρχοντος, ὁ, ruler (monarch)
γυνή, γυναικός, ἡ, woman, wife
(gynecology, androgynous)
ἕως, until; (+ gen.) to, as far as, to the
point of, until
θέλημα, -ατος, τό, will
νύξ, νυκτός, ἡ, night (nocturnal)

ὄνομα, -ατος, τό, name (anonymous,
pseudonym)
πνεῦμα, -ατος, τό, spirit, Spirit, wind,
breath (pneumatic, pneumonia)
ῥῆμα, -ατος, τό, word (rhetoric)
σάρξ, σαρκός, ἡ, flesh (sarcophagus,
sarcasm)
σπέρμα, -ατος, τό, seed, offspring,
children (sperm)
στόμα, -ατος, τό, mouth (stomach)
σῶμα, -ατος, τό, body (somatic)

Note -αἰών often occurs in idioms: εἰς τὸν αἰῶνα (or τοὺς αἰῶνας), “forever”; εἰς τοὺς αἰῶνας τῶν αἰώνων, “forever and ever”; ἕως τοῦ αἰῶνος, “forever” (LXX).
