αἷμα, -ατος, τό, blood (hemo-)

αἰών, αἰῶνος, ό, age, world (eon)

άνήρ, άνδρός, ό, man, husband
(android, androgynous)

άρχων, άρχοντος, ό, ruler (monarch)

γυνή, γυναικός, ή, woman, wife
(gynecology, androgynous)

έως, until; (+ gen.) to, as far as, to the
point of, until

θέλημα, -ατος, τό, will

νύξ, νυκτός, ή, night (nocturnal)

όνομα, -ατος, τό, name (anonymous,
pseudonym)

πνεῦμα, -ατος, τό, spirit, Spirit, wind,
breath (pneumatic, pneumonia)

ρήμα, -ατος, τό, word (rhetoric)

σάρξ, σαρκός, ή, flesh (sarcophagus,
sarcasm)

σπέρμα, -ατος, τό, seed, offspring,
children (sperm)

στόμα, -ατος, τό, mouth (stomach)

σῶμα, -ατος, τό, body (somatic)

Note -αἰών often occurs in idioms: εἰς τὸν αἰῶνα (or τοὺς αἰῶνας), “forever”; εἰς τοὺς αἰῶνας τῶν αἰώνων, “forever and ever”; ἕως τοῦ αἰῶνος, “forever” (LXX).
