NOUNS:	אָדָם	' <i>ādām</i> (1) the proper name Adam; (2) a collective term (no pl.) mankind; (3) a singular noun (no pl.) a man [<i>'ādām</i> characterizes a man as opposed to what is not human, while <i>'iš</i> is man as opposed to woman or child.]
	אָדָמָה	' <i>ādāmāh</i> earth, ground, soil, landed property [sometimes synonymous with <i>'éreṣ</i> , which retains more of a geographical or political rather than agricultural sense]
	בְּהֵמָה	<i>bəhēmāh</i> (constr. בְּהֵמַת <i>behēmat</i>) (pl. - <i>ôt</i>) beast, animal, often used collectively
	רִמָּשׁ	<i>rémés</i> (no pl.) a collective term for all creeping things
	זָכָר	<i>zākār</i> (pl. - <i>îm</i>) a male
	נְקֵבָה	<i>nəqēbāh</i> a female
	שַׁבָּת	<i>šabbāt</i> (pl. irreg. שַׁבָּתוֹת <i>šabbātōt</i>) sabbath (f.)
ADJECTIVES:	שֵׁשִׁי	<i>šiššî</i> sixth (fem. שֵׁשִׁית <i>šiššît</i>)
	שְׁבִיעִי	<i>šabīî</i> seventh (fem. שְׁבִיעִית <i>šabīît</i>)
	אַחֵר	' <i>aḥēr</i> other, another (fem. אַחֶרֶת <i>'aḥeret</i> ; m. pl. אַחֵרִים <i>'aḥērîm</i> , f. pl. אַחֶרוֹת <i>'aḥērôt</i>)
VERBS:	יָצַר	<i>yāṣar</i> to form, fashion
