Nouns: אָדֶם 'ādam (1) the proper name Adam; (2) a collective term (no pl.) mankind; (3) a singular noun (no pl.) a man ['ādam characterizes a man as opposed to what is not human, while 'îš is man as opposed to woman or child.]

יאַדְמָה 'adamāh earth, ground, soil, landed property [sometimes synonymous with 'éreṣ, which retains more of a geographical or political rather than agricultural sense]

קּהֵמְה bəhēmāh (constr. בְּהֵמְת behĕmat) (pl. -ôt) beast, animal, often used collectively

רֶּמֶשׁ rémes (no pl.) a collective term for all creeping things

זָכָר zākַār (pl. -îm) a male

הַבְּבָה nəqēbāh a female

שַּבְּת šabbāt (pl. irreg. שַׁבְּתוֹת) sabbath (f.)

ADJECTIVES: שׁשׁי šiššî sixth (fem. שׁשׁי šiššît)
