Nouns: פָּה (pl. rare) mouth. Note the prepositional phrases עַל־פִּי, מְפִי, מְפִי with the meaning "in proportion to, according to." These may be used as conjunctions with בְּפִי אֲשֶׁר: אֲשֶׁר "according as." Note the phrase "unanimity"

יָד $y\bar{a}d$ (du. יְבְיִם; pl. - $\hat{o}\underline{t}$) hand, side, (fig.) force (f.)

קַ dām (pl. -îm) blood

לֶבוֹד kābôd glory, honor, wealth

מְנְחָה minḥāh (pl. מְנָחוֹת) offering

Verbs: פָּבֵד $k\bar{a}b\bar{e}d$ to be heavy, important, serious; adj. פָּבֵד $k\bar{a}b\bar{e}d$.

קְּלֵא mālē' to be full, filled, fulfilled. No preposition is required in Hebrew: מְלָאָה הָאָּבֶץ רָשָה The earth was filled with wickedness. Adj. מְלֵא mālē', full.

מֵת mē<u>t</u> to die; adj. מֵת mē<u>t</u> dead

 $b\bar{o}$ to be ashamed (no corresponding adj.)

שַׁמֵּר šāmar to watch, keep, observe

עָבַד 'āḇaḏ to serve, work; till (the ground)

קְּרָה hārāh to become angry, used impersonally with יְּרָה hārāh to become angry, used impersonally with יְּרָה לָאִישׁ. The man became angry.

רָעָה $r\bar{a}'\bar{a}h$ to tend (flocks), to shepherd (+ dir. obj. or + $r\bar{a}'$; to graze; רֹעֵה $r\bar{a}'eh$ a shepherd
