קְרֵגֵּל *məraggēl* (pl. -*îm*) spy, scout אָמֶת '*ĕméṯ* (w. suff. אֲמֶתְּי; no pl.) truth

VERBS:

נְבְחֵן bāḥan (יִבְחֵן) to test, try, examine

OTHER:

hay | a form of תָּיִים (life) used before proper as God lives, תַּיִּי מַּרְעֹה hê | nouns in an oath: תַּיִּ אֱלֹהִים as God lives, תֵּי פַּרְעֹה as Pharaoh lives; cf. אָם below.

'im (conj.) if; note the full oath formula: hay/hê X 'im + imperf., where אָם has a negative force. E.g.

... הֵי מָנְאוּ מְזֶה כִּי־אָם As the Pharaoh lives, you shall *not* leave here unless . . .

קלי *kull*- all, every one of. Used with pronominal suffixes, in apposition: קאָנְשִׁים כָּלָם all of the men (lit. the men, all of them).
