NOUNS:

מַרְגֵּל *māraggēl* (pl. -îm) spy, scout

אֵמֶת *'emét* (w. suff. אֵמֶתִי ; no pl.) truth

VERBS:

בָּחַן *bāḥan* (יִבְחֶן) to test, try, examine

OTHER:

הֵי *hay* } a form of הֵי (living) or חַיִּים (life) used before proper
הֵי *hê* } nouns in an oath: הֵי אֱלֹהִים as God lives, הֵי פַרְעֹה as
Pharaoh lives; cf. אִם below.

אִם *'im* (conj.) if; note the full oath formula: *hay/hê X 'im + imperf.*, where אִם has a negative force. E.g.

... הֵי פַרְעֹה אִם תִּצְאוּ מִזֶּה כִּי־אִם... As the Pharaoh lives, you shall *not* leave here unless . . .

כָּל- *kull-* all, every one of. Used with pronominal suffixes, in apposition: הָאֲנָשִׁים כָּלָם all of the men (lit. the men, all of them).
