	יָשָׁר	<i>yāšār</i>	just, upright
	צַדִּיק	<i>ṣaddîq</i>	righteous
	קָשָׁה	<i>qāšeh</i>	difficult, hard, harsh
	רָשָׁע	<i>rāšā'</i>	evil, bad, criminal

PROPER NAMES:	דָּוִד	<i>Dāwīd</i>	David
	שְׁמוּאֵל	<i>šamû'el</i>	Samuel
	יְרוּשָׁלַיִם	<i>Yərûšālāim</i>	Jerusalem [Note that in the Hebrew spelling the second ם is missing. This spelling may point to an early dialectal variant pronunciation <i>Yərûšālêḡ</i>]
